ARC request and obtain approval before making changes will pay a \$75 fee. Those who submit and obtain approval





## Surge in burglaries a reminder to lock doors, windows, vehicles

## Pre-approved paint colors save residents time, money, stress

If you are painting your home in Parkwood Ranch, there are some things you need to know before beginning work.

• Only approved color schemes may be used in Parkwood Ranch.

• Painting requires approval from the Architectural Design Review Committee.

Parkwood Ranch has a list of pre-approved paint colors to help speed up the approval process. Although these colors are approved by the Board, residents still need to submit an architectural request PRIOR to beginning work.
